11:03AM - Since when do desert rains include tidal waves?



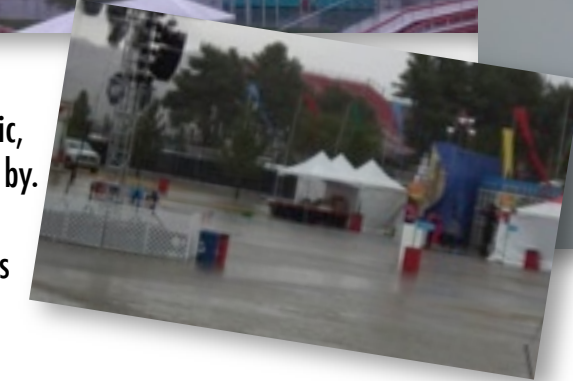
11:15AM - We've covered everything in plastic, including ourselves. Noah's Ark just floated by.
